3. ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible to enter this meeting all riders must be racing members of the NEW ERA MCC LTD and hold a **NOVICE LICENCE OR ABOVE** issued by the ACU or the Scottish ACU. Entries will be accepted from other European FMNs Licence Holders subject to the production of Starting Permission and confirmation of FIM Insurance cover. Licences must be produced when signing on.

10. TECHNICAL CONTROL: Between 8.00am and 10.00am ONLY. Riders to present themselves fully clothed in their leathers etc., as for racing, at Technical Control.
11. PRACTICE: From 9.30am to 11.00am. 3 Laps to qualify. **No racing engine to be run before 9.25am.**
12. STARTING: All races will be by Clutch start. Club Championship Conditions Article 11 refers.
13. FINISHING: For details of the finish of a race see Club Championship Conditions, Article 13.
14. **Restricted Novice and Intermediate Novice licence holders are required to wear an Orange Jacket at all our meetings.**
15. Slick or Moulded tyres permitted unless otherwise stated. See New Era Tech. Rule 3 of the Championship Conditions
16. **Paddock bikes are not permitted anywhere in the circuit grounds at any time.**
17. Please note that dogs are strictly forbidden in all circumstances and whether or not they are in vehicles.
18. See New Era Tech. Rule 6 of the Championship Conditions for Fire Extinguisher requirements.
19. Passes will be issued: Solo - 3 passes/competitor, Sponsors (if full details given) - 1 pass (Sent to Rider)
