1. **ANNOUNCEMENT:** A European Open Competition inscribed with the UEM, presented and promoted by the Clubmans Racing MCC EM and organised in association with the New Era MCC Ltd., to be held under the National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations of the A.C.U., these Supplementary Regulations and any other Final Instructions issued or Official Announcements made.

3. **ELIGIBILITY:** **NOTE:** Free Day Racing Membership of the New Era MCC will be granted to all riders who wish to enter. To be eligible to enter this meeting all riders must be racing members of either the Clubmans Racing MCC EM or the NEW ERA MCC and hold a NOVICE LICENCE OR ABOVE issued by the ACU or the Scottish ACU.

4. **ENTRIES:**

The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry. Entries by Fax are not permitted unless by prior arrangement with the Secretary.

FEES: Solos: £80 per machine irrespective of the number of races entered. Sidecars: £90 for one or all races. Day Racing Membership is free of Charge for this meeting - any rider wishing to join the Club as a Racing Member for 2010 should enclose an extra £25

PAYMENT: By Cheque payable to NEW ERA MCC Ltd. or by Credit Card All entries received after closing date are subject to a £20 late entry fee which is not refundable.

INSURANCE: The Club undertakes to insure each rider and passenger, indemnifying him/her against any third party claims made arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other drivers or passengers, entrant, sponsor or mechanic.

CANCELLED ENTRIES: Cancellations with all Paperwork sent back and received in the Office within 7 days before the event will qualify for a Voucher towards another meeting. Such Vouchers cannot be redeemed for cash.

5. **LIMITATION** Maximum Starters: **Practice:** Solos 48 **Racing:** Solos 32 (36 for 125cc)

6. **RIDER CHANGES** Rider/Passenger or Machine, but not both, may be changed on request in writing to the Secretary by 9.30am on the day of the meeting.

7. **AWARDS:** A Best Performance Award will be made to the Best Solo, the Best Novice Solo and the Best Sidecar Driver and Passenger. A Memento of the event will be awarded to every other Rider and Passenger who is a Finisher in at least one race during the Meeting.

8. **PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME:**

C1 & C2	Two	10 Lap races for Sidecars - Formula 1, Formula 2, Vintage and Classic
D1 & D2	Two	10 Lap races for Supermoto Type Machines

9. **COURSE:** The Circuit is 1.39 miles in length and is located off the A47 in Kirkby Mallory Village. The course includes Edwinas and the Bus Stop but not the Gerrards Chicane.
10. **SCRUTINY** Between 8.00am and 9.00am ONLY. Riders to present themselves fully clothed as for racing at Technical Control
11. **PRACTICE:** From 9.30am to 11.00am. 3 Laps to qualify. No racing engine to be run before 9.30am.
12. **STARTING:** All races will be by Clutch start.
13. **FINISHING:** To be counted as a finisher a rider must have completed 80% of the full race distance.
14. **NOVICES:** Restricted Novice and Intermediate Novice licence holders are required to wear an Orange Jacket at all our meetings.
15. **TYRES:** Slick or Moulded tyres permitted unless otherwise stated.
16. **MINI-BIKES:** Paddock bikes are not permitted anywhere in the circuit grounds at any time.
17. **ANIMALS:** Please note that dogs are strictly forbidden in all circumstances and whether or not they are in vehicles.
18. **SAFETY:** See New Era Tech. Rule 6 of the Championship Conditions for Fire Extinguisher requirements.
19. **PASSES:** Passes will be issued: Solo - 3 passes/competitor, Sidecars 5, Sponsors (if full details given) - 1 pass (Sent to Rider)
20. **PHOTOS:** By taking part in this meeting you accept that Photographs may be taken for promotional purposes and may appear on the New Era website or in New Era publications.
21. **CANCELLATIONS:** Entry Fees will only be returned if the meeting is cancelled. If the meeting has to be cancelled due to weather conditions, Entry Fees will be returned less £30 towards the administration fees incurred by the Club.
22. **CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT DUE TO BAD WEATHER** In the event of bad weather it will be up to each Rider or his Entrant to contact the Secretary during the week before the event for the latest information. Under no circumstances whatsoever on Christmas Day please.
