- ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible to enter this meeting all riders must be racing members of the NEW ERA MCC LTD and hold a 2010 CLUBMAN LICENCE OR ABOVE issued by the ACU or the Scottish ACU. Entries will be accepted from other European FMNs Licence Holders subject to the production of Starting Permission and confirmation of FIM Insurance cover. Licences must be produced when signing on.

4. ENTRIES:

FEES: Solos: £125 for the first 2 Championship races. Entry Fees for Dutch Ducati Series Riders is £155 as includes extra Training. If an extra Class (2 Races plus Practice) is entered then that is an extra £60. The Club may refuse any entry.

PAYMENT: MUST BE FOR THE FULL AMOUNT

By Cheque payable to NEW ERA MCC Ltd OR by Credit Card Any late entry accepted on the day of the event is subject to a £20 late entry fee. Credit Card payments will be input no earlier than the Monday of the week in which the event takes place.

INSURANCE: The Club undertakes to insure each rider and passenger, indemnifying him/her against any third party claims made arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other drivers or passengers, entrant, sponsor or mechanic.

CANCELLED ENTRIES: Entries cancelled up to 3 days before the event - fees will be returned less £40 No refunds will be payable afterwards.

5. **LIMITATION:** Maximum Starters: Practice: Solos 60 Racing: Solos 40

6. **RIDER CHANGES** Changes to Rider or Machine but not both may be made up to 9.00am on the day of the meeting.

7. **AWARDS:** Trophies will be awarded to the first three finishers in each Class subject to the number of entries received. The Towcester Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the first Two-Stroke Trophy Race

B1 - B2	Two 10 Lap races for Bridgestone Open Championship for 700 - 1300cc with Superstocks. Any Tyre
C1 - C2	Two 10 Lap races for New Era Junior Championship for Solos 70 to 690cc Any Tyre
D1 - D2	Two 10 Lap races for "Sound of Thunder" (Twins/Triples) plus SV 650 & Maxxis Corse Series Co-Ordinator David Nicholson
E1 - E2	Two 10 Lap races for Bridgestone Formula Xtreme 600-675, inc. Pirelli / Metzeler Formula 600, plus Pre-inject, Steel Frame - Formula Xtreme on Slicks - other Classes on Moulded Treaded Tyres
F1 - F2	Two 10 Lap races for Honda Hornets, CB500, Supermoto and Open 400cc
G1 - G2	Two 10 Laps races for Ducati Desmo Due A & B - Co-Ordinator Chris Bushell
H1 - H2	Two 10 Laps races for the Ducati 8848 Series - Co-Ordinator Chris Bushell
J1 - J2	Two 10 Laps races for the Dutch Ducati Riders Championships - Co-Ordinator Ton de Bruijn
P1 - P2	Two 10 Lap races for the Maxxis Corse Championship - Co-Ordinator David Nicholson (S.O.T)

Grid positions will be by Timed Practice Separate Championship in each Class for Red Jacket wearers as at 1.3.10

All Championships will have Newcomers Class (Red Jackets at 1/3/10) and a Clubman Class (Clubman Licences at 1/3/10)

9. **COURSE:** The Circuit is 1.64 miles in length and is located off the A43 Road near Towcester in Northamptonshire Postcode: NN12 8TN

10. **TECHNICAL** From 7.30am to 10.00am. Riders are to present themselves fully clothed in their leathers etc., as for racing.

11. **PRACTICE:** From 9.30am to 11.00am. 3 Laps to qualify. No racing engine to be run before 9.25am.

12. **STARTING:** All races will be by Clutch start.

13. **FINISHING:** To be a finisher a Rider must finish the race within 2 minutes of the winner and have completed 85% of the full race distance.

14. **NEWCOMERS:** Riders required to wear an Orange Jacket must do so at all times please.

15. **TYRES:** Slick or Moulded tyres permitted unless otherwise stated.

16. **ANIMALS:** Prohibited in all circumstances and whether or not they are in vehicles

17. **PASSES:** Passes for classes/competitor, Sponsors (if full details given) - 1 pass (Sent to Rider)
